A LAW TO AMEND THE POLICE LAW.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Police (Amendment No. 3) Law, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Police Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. Section 25A of the principal Law (as set out in section 2 of Law 21 of 1955) is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following new sub-section :—

"(4) The Commissioner may, by writing under his hand, delegate to any person, subject to such limitations and directions as he may in such instrument provide, any of the powers conferred upon him by the provisions of this section."
