2. Section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of sub-section (4) and the substitution therefor of the following sub-section :—

“(4) Any person detained under a detention order shall be deemed to be in lawful custody and the provisions of any Law in force for the time being relating to any person in lawful custody for any criminal or other offence shall apply to a person detained under a detention order as they apply to a person in lawful custody for any criminal or other offence.”

A LAW TO AUTHORISE THE USE OF HER MAJESTY'S FORCES IN  
THE PERFORMANCE OF POLICE DUTIES.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and  
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as  
follows :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as Her Majesty's Forces (Performance of Police Duties) Law, 1955.

2. The Governor may direct that members of Her Majesty's Forces shall have power to carry out and perform duties which members of the Cyprus Police Force are authorised by the law in force for the time being to carry out and perform, and in the carrying out and performance of any such duties members of Her Majesty's Forces shall have all the powers, privileges and protection conferred upon a member of the Cyprus Police Force under the provisions of the law in force for the time being.

3. The Governor may amend, vary or revoke any direction, given under section 2, by a subsequent direction.
