## THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 30 OF 1956.

A Law to amend the Sheep, Goats and Pigs (ENUMERATION) LAW.

CAP. 158.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Sheep, Goats and Pigs Short title. (Enumeration) (Amendment) Law, 1956, and shall be read as Cap. 158. one with the Sheep, Goats and Pigs (Enumeration) Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. The definition of "enumerator" contained in section 2 Amendment of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion of section 2 of the therein, immediately after the words "police officer" (line 1), principal of the words "or other person".

3. Sub-section (1) of section 4 of the principal Law is hereby Amendment amended by the insertion therein, immediately after the words of section 4 "police officers" (line 2), of the words "or other persons".
