A LAW TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS TARIFF LAWS, 1954 TO 1956. 64 of 1954

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs Tariff Short title.
(Amendment No. 2) Law, 1956, and shall be read as one with
the Customs Tariff Laws, 1954 to 1956 (hereinafter referred 64 of 1954
to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this 29 of 1955
Law may together be cited as the Customs Tariff Laws, 1 of 1956.
1954 to (No. 2) 1956.

Amendment of Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal Law.

2. Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal Law (under the heading "Goods Liable to Customs Duty") is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) by the alterations and substitutions specified in the second column of Part I of the First Schedule to this Law, of the items of Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal Law, specified in the first column of Part I of the First Schedule to this Law ;
- (b) by the insertion in Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal Law, in their proper numerical order, of the new items specified in Part II of the First Schedule to this Law.

36E.	In item 36E there shall be added at the end the following words :— "Chlorine, including chlorine preparations for the production of insecticides."

174E.	174E. Fresh fruit imported by a manufacturer of canned products or jams which the importer declares and the Comptroller is satisfied are to be used solely in the manufacture of such products in the Colony.
175E.	175E. Army Kinema Corporation and Royal Air Force Cinema Corporation : Motor vehicles, cinema projectors, wireless receiving sets, cinema equipment of a non-consumable nature and films, the property of, and imported by or on behalf of the Army Kinema Corporation or the Royal Air Force Cinema Corporation, which are certified by the Commander, Cyprus District or by the Air Officer Commanding, Royal Air Force, Levant, as the case may be, are to be imported solely for the purpose of and in connection with the activities in the Colony of the said Corporations and to be not for resale.”
