BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor Short title. (Manufacture) Licensing (Amendment) Law, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Intoxicating Liquor (Manufacture) Licensing 24 of 1950 Laws, 1950 and 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal 21 of 1954 Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor (Manufucture) Licensing Laws, 1950 to 1957.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 12 of the principal Law is Amendment hereby amended by the substitution for the words "six shillings" of section 12 (line 4) of the words "six hundred mils".
