THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 5 OF 1957.

A LAW TO AMEND THE ENGLISH SCHOOL (MANAGEMENT AND CAP. 204
CONTROL) LAW.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the English School (Management and Control) (Amendment) Law, 1957, and shall be read as one with the English School (Management and Control) Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

Short title.
Cap. 204

Repeal of section 4 of the principal Law and substitution of new section.

2. Section 4 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

“ Board of Management.

4.—(1) The English School, either in its present form or in such modified form as may be determined by the Governor under the provisions of section 3 (1) (a), shall be managed and controlled by a Board of Management consisting of a Chairman and eight other members, who shall be fit and proper persons appointed by the Governor :

Provided that no less than four of the number of such nine persons shall be former pupils of the English School.

(2) The Governor may at any time terminate the appointment of any member of the Board of Management.

(3) The Governor may upon the death, resignation, retirement or termination of appointment of any member of the Board of Management appoint another fit and proper person to fill the vacancy.

(4) The Governor may in the case of illness or absence from the Colony of any member of the Board of Management appoint a fit and proper person in the place of such member until such member shall resume his duties.

(5) The Board of Management shall conduct its meetings and proceedings and shall manage and control the English School in accordance with regulations made by it and approved by the Governor.”
