**THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS**

**No. 17 OF 1957.**

A LAW TO AMEND THE MOTOR VEHICLES (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) LAW, 1954. 62 of 1954

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) (Amendment) Law, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Law, 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Laws, 1954 and 1957. 2. Sub-section (4) of section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the substitution of the following paragraphs for paragraphs (c) and (d) thereof :—

- “(c) to any person or class of persons declared by the Governor-in-Council to be exempted from the provisions of this Law, subject to such conditions, if any, as the Governor-in-Council may deem fit to impose ; or
- (d) to any motor vehicle or type of motor vehicle declared by the Governor-in-Council to be exempted from the provisions of this Law, subject to such conditions, if any, as the Governor-in-Council may deem fit to impose.”.
