BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor (Manufacture) Licensing (Amendment) Law, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Intoxicating Liquor (Manufacture) Licensing Laws, 1950 to (No. 2) 1957, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor (Manufacture) Licensing Laws, 1950 to 1958.

Short title and construction.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 12 of the principal Law is hereby amended by deleting the words "six hundred mils" which occur in the fourth line thereof and by substituting therefor the words "nine hundred mils".

Amendment of section 12 of the principal Law.

3. This Law shall come into operation on the 27th day of April, 1958.
