BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as

1. This Law may be cited as the Turkish Family Courts short title. (Amendment) Law, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Turkish Family Courts Law, 1954, (hereinafter referred to as 42 of 1954. "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Turkish Family Courts Laws, 1954 and 1958.

2. Section 14 of the principal Law is hereby amended by Amendment substituting the word "fifty" for the word "ten" in the second line thereof.

1.—(1) This Law may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Amendment) (No. 2) Law, 1958 and shall be read as one with the Customs Tariff Laws, 1954 to 1958 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal 64 of 1954 Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Customs Tariff Laws, 1954 to (No. 2) 1958.

(2) This Law shall come into operation on the 7th day of 16 of 1957 September 1059.
