BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor at Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus follows :--

Short title. Construction.

1. This Law may be cited as the Port Workers (Regulation of Employment) (Amendment) Law, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Port Workers (Regulation of Employment) Laws, 1952 and 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law ") and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Port Workers (Regulation of Employment) Laws, 1952 to 1958.

Section 2 of the principal Law amended.

2. Section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended by substituting a semi-colon for the full stop at the end of paragraph (e) of the definition of 'port worker' and by inserting immediately after the said paragraph the following further paragraph to be lettered (f):-

" (f) any porter regularly employed in an enclosed area allocated by the Comptroller for the use of Her

Majesty's Forces.
